



AFL Central Victoria Commission Position Description

Commission Role

The AFL Central Victoria Commission exists to enable country football and netball to grow within our region through its strategic deliberations and actions. The strategic component of the business is governed by the Commission and implemented by the Region General Manager (RGM).

Declaration of Conflict of Interest

Commissioners must ensure that any conflict of interest is identified and managed in accordance with established principles so as to protect the public interest and maintain the integrity of AFL Central Victoria. In all deliberations as a Commissioner, no bias to any club, league or association can prejudice any discussion or decision-making process that you are involved in.

Commission Meetings

Commission meetings are the forum where strategic discussions and deliberations are held, and decisions are made. The RGM reports on agenda items for information purposes or for adoption by the Commission. Operational reports are made available to Commissioners to review prior to a scheduled Commission meeting. Discussion on operational items should only occur on an exception basis and should firstly be raised with the RGM for inclusion as a Commission meeting agenda item.

Strategic Planning

Commissioners should:

- Identify strategic planning initiatives when they arise.
- Attend the strategic planning sessions to update the current AFL Central Victoria strategic plan which will then recognise all latest strategy initiatives and implementation plans.

Involvement

Commissioners should have an involvement in AFL Central Victoria's strategic business, so they have a good understanding thereof.

Interaction

Commissioners are encouraged to interact with the RGM and fellow Commissioners on agenda items between meetings.

Projects

Commissioners should be prepared to use their knowledge and individual skill sets by becoming actively involved from time to time in relevant projects and sub-committees.

Stakeholders

Commissioners should interact with our AFL Central Victoria stakeholders and follow up any strategic issues that they might have.

Ambassadorship

At all times, Commissioners must represent AFL Central Victoria professionally and proudly amongst our stakeholders. All Commission decisions must be accepted, endorsed and fully supported by all Commissioners. All Commission matters must remain in strictest confidence.

Interaction with RGM

Commissioners should liaise with the RGM to understand the status of developing issues.

Behaviour

Commissioners must always act professionally and in the best interests of AFL Central Victoria as well as in accordance with the Commission's Code of Conduct.
